





The Great Falls Model Railroad Club meets on the third Thursday of every month from 6:30 to 9 p.m. at 144 Mill Street in Auburn, Maine (see map for location). Club meetings usually include a railroad video for the first thirty minutes, a business meeting, and helpful “how-to” clinics. Members share modeling ideas and techniques at the Modelers Forum on the fourth Thursday of the month. Construction on the permanent multi-level HO layout continues on Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings, with operating sessions twice a month. Other members are continuing work on the club’s permanent N, O and G-scale layouts.

The club has an extensive library with books, magazines, slides, videos and historical papers. Members are encouraged to use the library for research and enjoyment. Locomotives and rolling stock in various scales as well as DVD’s and other railroad items are available for sale at the club.

As part of our community outreach and educational emphasis, club members provide special programs and take our modular layout to schools, museums, hospitals, nursing homes, and public events. The club supports Operation Lifesaver, an organization dedicated to explaining railroad safety to students and other groups of all ages, interests, and occupations.

We host model railroad shows in April and November at Mt. Ararat High School in Topsham, ME. Special events at the clubhouse include ExTRAINaganza during the last two weekends in November.

Member videographers have made popular thirty-minute shows seen on cable tel-

evision stations throughout Maine and at club meetings, which can be viewed online, borrowed from the club library or purchased. *TRAIN TIME* videos currently include real trains from New York, New England, Pennsylvania, and California.

The Great Falls Model Railroad Club membership is open to families, students, and individuals of all ages. The club is a 501(c)(3) educational foundation recognized by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS); therefore, gifts made to the club may be tax deductible.
