INSTRUCTIONS FOR No. 3464 OPERATING BOX CAR




Figure 1-No. 3464 Box Car Positioned for Opening Door

To open the couplers or the door of the No. 3464 Box Car a special Remote Control Section of track is required. The Remote Control Section used with "O" gauge track is the UCS; the section matching "027" track is No. 6019. One of these sections is included with every Lionel train set. To permit operation in various places in the layout additional sections can be purchased from your dealer.

Note: This car cannot be operated by the old RCS and No. 1019 Remote Control Sections which have no central electromagnets.

HOW TO OPERATE THE CAR

To open the door and make the crewman appear, position the plunger in the bottom of the car directly over the track electromagnet (See Figure 1). Then press the "Uncouple" button. Once opened, the door does not close automatically. Slide the door shut by hand to move the man back into the car and to reset the mechanism.

HOW TO COUPLE AND UNCOUPLE THE CAR




Figure 2-Box Car Positioned for Uncoupling

To uncouple cars the front wheels of either truck must be directly above the electromagnet. (See Figure 2). Pressing the "Uncouple" button will pull down the iron armature plate under the truck and allow the coupler to snap open. To couple cars simply push them together. Only one of the mating couplers has to be open for the cars to couple. If both are closed, move the car to the Remote Control Section and push the "Uncouple" button.

A letter in a stamped envelope stating fully the service desired must be pasted to the outside wrapper, since postal regulations do not permit a letter or any written message to be placed inside the package.
