

How to Install No. 410 Billboard Blinker

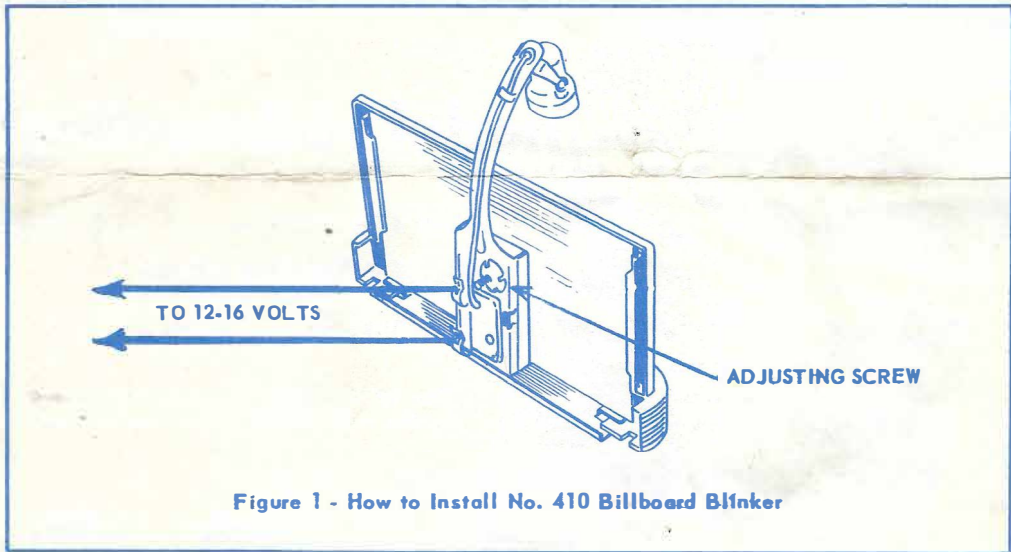


Figure 1 - How to Install No. 410 Billboard Blinker

No. 410 Billboard Blinker is made to fit any Lionel billboard sign. The blinker base slides on the frame of the billboard from the back so that the lamp bracket curves over the front of the billboard.

The two spring clips in the back of the blinker are connected to a track lockon or directly to the transformer posts which give 12-16 volts. When connected in this way the blinker will cause the lamp to go off and on illuminating the sign in a realistic fashion.

The period of blinking can be varied by means of the adjusting screw in the back. Turning the screw clockwise will increase the illuminated periods. To obtain continuous lighting turn the screw clockwise until blinking stops. When adjusting, turn the screw a little at a time and allow enough time in each position for the blinking element to reach a steady rhythm of operation.

If the lamp in the blinker burns out replace it with 6-8 volt lamp No. L51 available from your Lionel dealer. To remove lamp push it into its socket and turn slightly counter-clockwise.

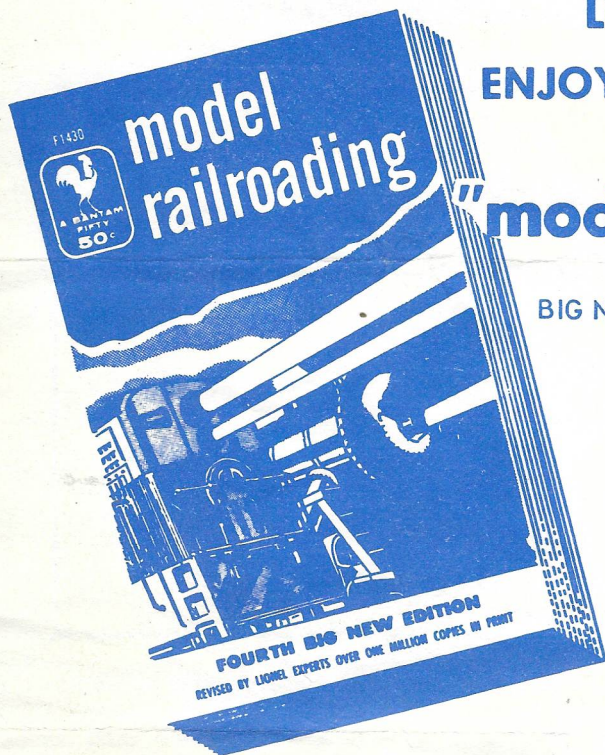
